Year 10 into 11 Transition Meeting Wednesday 17th June 2015

I am writing to you to outline some of the key initiatives that your son/daughter will be involved in during Year 11.

- ◆ 6 Lesson Day – All Year 11 pupils will have an additional lesson most days (Lesson 6), outlined on their individual timetables. Lesson 6 will run from 3 – 4 pm. This lesson is key to pupil performance and focuses on practicing skills learned in lessons, revision techniques and preparation for GCSE exams. All pupils are expected to attend these lessons. Pupils will receive rewards for their efforts in their lessons and we offer support to individuals if there are transport issues.
- ◆ Intervention – if required, your son/daughter may receive additional ‘Intervention’ lessons, especially in English & Maths, to ensure they achieve their target grade.
- ◆ Additional Revision – there will be additional revision sessions held throughout the year, details of which will be given closer to the time. For example, during February half-term, Easter Holidays and May half-term, there will be revision sessions at school. We need your support in ensuring pupils attend these sessions.
- ◆ Assertive Mentoring – some pupils will be included in the Assertive Mentoring programme, if we feel they require additional support. This is run by SLT and senior teachers.
- ◆ Learning Coaches – we have Learning Coaches available during the school day, and after school hours, to assist your son/daughter if they have fallen behind in any subjects, or to help them complete homework etc.
